What is the organization's primary mission? Peace Action is a national, grassroots based organization that works to build citizen support for budget priorities that fund human needs, eliminate weapons of mass destruction, and increase international cooperation.

Communication, Education and Advocacy:

Peace Action staff has continued to provide leadership in the National Security Working Group (NSWG), a monthly meeting of 10-30 NGO leaders, congressional staff and occasionally Members of Congress to foster collaboration and coordination on the development and implementation of strategy and policy alternatives to affect change on national security issues.

The coalition arranges for conference space, reserves speakers and facilitates meetings. Detailed notes are provided to a list of 200 NGO leaders and 1,000 congressional staff.

Peace Action also maintains and is planning further upgrades to its website at www.peace-action.org. Peace Action mails action alerts to its membership list and sends daily updates to its list of affiliates and activists lists. Peace Action continues to support and grow its online activist list with over 60,000 members and groups, reaching another 100,000 activists via Peace Action national and affiliate listservs;

Afghanistan: Peace Action leaders chair the Afghanistan Policy Working Group, with a listsery of staff persons from roughly 120 organizations. The Working Group coordinates congressional, administration and grassroots strategies to accelerate withdrawal from Afghanistan, supporting legislation, including bills to fully fund the full and safe withdrawal of all troops and contractors in advance of the withdrawal deadline of December 2014 set by President Obama and other legislation to require Congressional

approval before troops can remain in Afghanistan after the deadline.

Peace Action increased its communications and advocacy insure all US troops and contractors return home by the end of 2014.

Budget Priorities: Peace Action's Move the Money coalition continued to grow at the national and local levels, the result of aggressive outreach and education campaigns organized by Peace Action and its chapters and affiliates.

Peace Action organized several call/email campaigns around key votes in Congress on military budget issues and generated hundreds of news articles and letters to the editor in local press across the country around its Move the Money campaign.

Peace Action has also been successful in linking its Move the Money work with a growing coalition of international peace groups working to reduce world military expenditures. In 2013, Peace Action was chosen as the US convener of the 4th annual Global Days of Action on Military Spending which produced tax day actions across the US and in over 20 other counties.

Peace Action chapters led dozens of April 15th Tax Day actions, a staple of local organizing around the country. Peace Action chapters conducted public education and outreach events and with the assistance from the national office, disseminated fact sheets and organized resources to help make these events effective.

Disarmament: Peace Action participates in the Nuclear Weapons Working Group, Peace and Security Initiative, the Alliance for Nuclear Accountability, the Fissile Materials Working Group to coordinate advocacy and actions around a broad range of issues from advocacy for a Middle East Nuclear Free Zone treaty to efforts to cut funding for nuclear weapons.

SANE Act: In February 2013, Rep. Ed Markey reintroduced the SANE Act, the Smarter Approach to Nuclear Expenditures Act, designed to slash U.S. nuclear weapons expenditures by \$100 billion over the next decade. Markey's bill became the focal point for Congressional education and grassroots organizing around nuclear weapons issues, serving as a policy alternative to plans for 'modernizing' the nuclear weapons complex.

Executive Director Kevin Martin represented Peace Action at a special session of the General Assembly at the United Nations on nuclear disarmament.

Organizational Development:

In support of the development of a new chapter in West Palm Beach, FL, Field Director Judith LeBlanc delivered a sermon to 300 people at a local church, delivered lectures at three local colleges and participated in two public forums. LeBlanc also lead a planning and strategy session with statewide activists in New Hampshire and Maine.

LeBlanc also moderated a live stream online teach-in on Syria's civil war and helped facilitate a strategic planning meeting of peace groups on the Asia-Pacific pivot.

Finally, Executive Director Kevin Martin facilitated a planning retreat for Peace Action Michigan and was featured speaker at events organized by the chapter and conducted media interviews scheduled by the affiliate. Martin also assisted in strategy and planning meetings in Masschusetts, New York

Affiliate and Member Services:

In January, Peace Action's national office organizes and hosts a annual gathering of key organizers and chapter leaders to develop

coordinated work plans for the coming year.

Peace Action's Political Director, Paul Kawika Martin, organizes twice monthly conference calls for all members of our grassroots network to review progress on our plans and refine strategy and tactics in pursuit of our goals.

The National staff also continued its organization of membership renewal campaigns for chapters and affiliates at their request. In 2012, the national office provided these services for Peace Action of Delaware Valley and Montgomery Country (Maryland) Peace Action.

Working with affiliate staff in New Jersey and Massachusetts, National staff conducted a coordinated outreach to major donors, helping these affiliates build stronger relationships with major donors.

Also, a number of surveys were developed for individual members and chapters/affiliates to gather input on membership and other organizational issues both to providing a more structured avenue for gathering and sharing input to help focus the work of the national organization.
