What is the organization's primary mission? Peace Action is a national, grassroots based organization that works to build citizen support for budget priorities that fund human needs, eliminate weapons of mass destruction, and increase international cooperation.

Communication, Education and Advocacy:

Peace Action staff has continued to provide leadership in the National Security Working Group (NSWG), a monthly meeting of 10-30 NGO leaders, congressional staff and occasionally Members of Congress to foster collaboration and coordination on the development and implementation of strategy and policy alternatives to affect change on national security issues.

Peace Action mails action alerts to its membership list and sends daily updates to its list of affiliates and activists lists. Peace Action continues to support and grow its online activist list with over 55,000 members and groups, reaching another 100,000 activists via Peace Action national and affiliate listservs. Peace Action also maintains its website at www.peace-action.org.

Afghanistan: As the December, 2014 withdrawal deadline from Afghanistan approached, President Obama announced announced his plan to extend our longest war in history at least two-and-a-half more years by leaving 9,800 troops in Afghanistan. Peace Action opposed this backtracking on ending US military operations in Afghanistan and mobilzed grassroots opposition while continuting to support fully funding the full and safe withdrawal of all troops and contractors in advance of the withdrawal deadline of December 2014 set by President Obama.

Iran: Peace Action had hoped to end 2014 in celebration over the successful conclusion of historic talks between Iran and the P5 +1. Instead, a last minute push to extend the talks was required to prevent the failure of negotiations to resolve the conflict over Iran's nuclear program without the use of military force.

Much of Peace Action's work has centered on preventing those who favor threats and intimidation over diplomacy from winning a new round of punishing sanctions to force Iran to knuckle under. Such measures would poison negotiations and potentially lead to military action.

Over the course of 2014, Peace Action has focused grassroots pressure on Congress and the administration on numerous occasions through a series of alerts mailed, phoned and emailed to Peace Action members and chapters.

ISIS: The advance of the so-called Islamic State (sometimes referred to as ISIS) caught the US national apparatus by surprise. Immediately the call for war was sounded and Peace Action mobilzed grassroots opposition while demanding a full and open debate in Congress on the required authorization of military force. Peace Action made educational resources in ISIS available to its members and provided regular updates on fast moving events in the region.

Budget Priorities: Peace Action's Move the Money coalition continued to grow at the national and local levels, the result of aggressive outreach and education campaigns organized by Peace

Action and its chapters and affiliates. Much of this outreach and education was directed at the abuse of the Overseas Contingency Operations account which the Pentagon was using to get around budget caps imposed by sequestration. Also, outreach and education focused on Peace Action's work to cancel the F-35.

Peace Action organized several call/email campaigns around key votes in Congress on military budget issues and generated hundreds of news articles and letters to the editor in local press across the country around its Move the Money campaign.

In 2014, for the 2nd year in a row, Peace Action participated in the 5th annual Global Days of Action on Military Spending which produced tax day actions across the US and in over 20 other counties.

Peace Action chapters led dozens of April 15th Tax Day actions, a staple of local organizing around the country. Peace Action chapters conducted public education and outreach events and with the assistance from the national office, disseminated fact sheets and organized resources to help make these events effective.

Disarmament: Peace Action participates in the Nuclear Weapons Working Group, Peace and Security Initiative, the Alliance for Nuclear Accountability, the Fissile Materials Working Group to coordinate advocacy and actions around a broad range of issues from advocacy for a Middle East Nuclear Free Zone treaty to efforts to cut funding for nuclear weapons. Peace Action staff and activists were in attendance at the United Nations at the preparatory conference of the Nuclear Non-Proliferation Treaty (NPT) in May.

Peace Action continued its support of the Smarter Approach to Nuclear Expenditures Act, or the SANE Act, designed to slash U.S. nuclear weapons expenditures by \$100 billion over the next decade. The SANE Act has become the focal point for Congressional education and grassroots organizing around nuclear weapons issues, serving as a policy alternative to plans for 'modernizing' the nuclear weapons complex. Peace Action supported bills in both the House and Senate.

Organizational Development:

Peace Action Executive Director Kevin Martin, Political Director Paul Kawika Martin (no relation) and Field Director Judith LeBlanc traveled across the country in 2014, provided direct consultation and chapter building assistance to local groups in CT, FL, MA, NJ, ME, NY. RI, TX, & WI,

Peace Action's Membership and Affiliation Committee provided how-to materials on membership acquisition and coordinated outreach to groups interested in affiliation with Peace Action.

During the summer of 2014, Peace Action, as a national endorser of the Peoples Climate March in New York City, jumped into the organizing from the very beginning, launching the Peace and Justice Hub. The Hub brought together peace and faith groups to organize a No War, No Warming contingent and rally.

Field Director Judith LeBlanc helped convene a working group of chapter leaders including, Cole Harrison, executive director of Massachusetts Peace Action (MAPA), Jim Anderson, Peace Action of New York State (PANYS) Chair and Natia Bueno, PANYS Student Outreach Coordinator, to plan and mobilize a strong peace presence at the march, coordinating outreach and preparing the logistics for the pre-march rally.

Finally, Executive Director Kevin Martin attended meetings in New York to develop and further a strategy for nuclear abolition leading up to the Nuclear Non-Proliferation Treaty review conference in 2015.

Affiliate and Member Services:

The National staff continued its organization of membership renewal campaigns for chapters and affiliates at their request. In 2014, the national office provided these services for Montgomery Country (Maryland).

Ntaional staff also provided assistance in list management to Peace Action of Wisconsin working with chapter staff to coordinate messaging.

Also, a number of surveys were developed for individual members and chapters/affiliates to gather input on membership and other organizational issues both to providing a more structured avenue for gathering and sharing input to help focus the work of the national organization.
